### **Job Purpose**

The Sessional Holiday Camp Worker will support the delivery of SOAC's free holiday camps for children aged 5–11 from ethnic communities living in Renfrewshire. The postholder will help create a safe, welcoming and stimulating environment where children can enjoy fun, creative, practical and physical activities during school holidays.

### **Main Duties and Responsibilities**

- Support the day-to-day delivery of holiday camp activities during Easter, Summer and October breaks.
- Help provide a safe, inclusive and enjoyable environment for children aged 5–11.
- Lead or support activities such as games, arts and crafts, outdoor play, sports, gardening, baking, sewing, singing, drumming and trips.
- Encourage children's participation, confidence, friendships and wellbeing.
- Listen to children's views and support them to make choices about activities.
- Work positively with volunteers, young leaders and other staff members.
- Ensure safeguarding, health and safety and behaviour procedures are followed at all times.
- Support registration, attendance, set-up, tidy-up and general organisation of sessions.
- Promote positive relationships with children, families and colleagues.
- Report any safeguarding or welfare concerns promptly in line with SOAC procedures.
